

## Cardiorespiratory Service for Pets: Information for Veterinary Surgeons

- I aim to provide a professional but friendly service. Patient well-being and client care are my top priorities.
- The diagnostics available are: electrocardiography, digital radiography, echocardiography (including Doppler and Colour Flow mapping), blood pressure measurement, laboratory testing, Holter monitoring and bronchoscopy. 24-hour hospital care is available.
- A full written report is emailed, usually within 2-3 days, often sooner. Whenever possible I prefer an email contact for speed and convenience but reports can also be sent via fax or post if you prefer.
- I endeavour to return cases to the referring veterinary surgeon for ongoing management whenever possible and appropriate. For your peace of mind, any patient you refer will not be accepted as a first opinion patient by MBM Vets for a minimum of 12 months following referral.

To request a referral appointment, the referring vet should contact the small animal department at MBM Vets on 01563 522701 (option 1) and email the client/patient history to nurses@mbmvetgroup.co.uk. We will subsequently arrange an appointment directly with your client.

- Clinic appointments are routinely available on Wednesday and Thursday afternoons.
- Please provide a full patient clinical history and, if possible, any available results of tests you
  have performed e.g. radiographs, blood results. These can be emailed to
  nurses@mbmvetgroup.co.uk
