Our team includes certificate holders in small animal medicine, feline medicine, dermatology, cardiology, ECC, and others currently working toward certificates in small animal medicine, surgery and ophthalmology. We are proud of our established network of internal referral services, enabling our vets to utilise the expertise of our certificate holder colleagues, in order to continually improve our level of service. We are also fortunate to have our physiotherapy team who further aid our ability to provide a comprehensive service to our patients and clients.

The role includes a mixture of consulting and operating, and our rota generally has a mixture of the two each day. Case continuity is a key focus for us, and we find this structure enables us to ensure the same vet remains responsible for each patient as often as possible. We can tweak the rota in favour of any preferences you may have.

Our vets generally work a four day week, with the same weekday off each week. The weekend rota is 1/8 full weekends (Saturday and Sunday, with following Friday off), and 1/8 half weekends (Friday evening and Saturday morning). There may be some sole charge branch work during the week and weekends, however another vet is never more than ten minutes away if assistance is needed! We pride ourselves on our support structure and strive to develop good team relationships.
