peworm treatment ogs (not cats) travelling to Northern Ireland, Malta, Ireland, Finland, or Norway (EU listed beworm free countries) will also require a treatment for tapeworms. This must be given a UK registered vet between 24 and 120 hours, i.e.1-5 days before travel. They will not en require further tapeworm treatment before returning home.					
Dogs travelling to all other EU countries do not need to be treated for tapeworms prior to travel, but must be a treated by a vet in the EU country between 24 and 120 hours of arriving back in the UK. The AHC must be presented to the vet so that he/she can record the					
treatment. Short trips: if you are returning within 120 hours (5 days), the tapeworm treatment will need to be administered and recorded by a vet in the UK
