

What to do if your cat goes missing

1 Check indoors first

Start by searching your home thoroughly. Cats often hide in unexpected places.



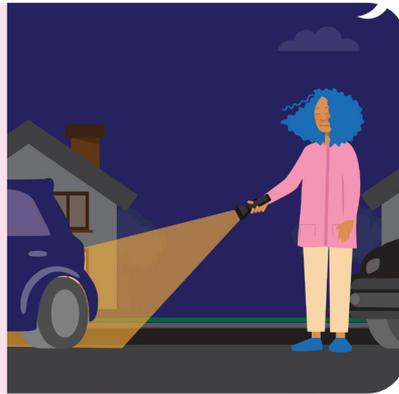
2 Use familiar sounds and smells

Shake a box of their favourite treats at your door and try leaving out a blanket, toy and a bowl of their favourite food to entice them back.



3 Search your local area

Look around your neighbourhood, calling their name. Check sheds, garages, and under cars.



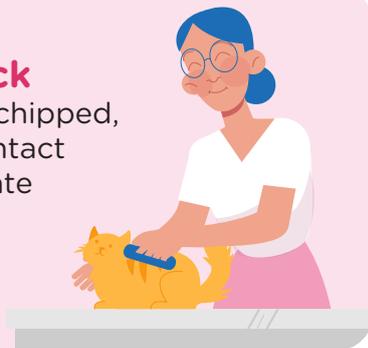
4 Spread the word

Tell your neighbours, post on local social media groups using recent photos, and contact your local vet and animal shelter.



5 Microchip check

If your cat is microchipped, make sure your contact details are up to date on the database.



6 Register your cat as missing

Register your cat as missing with your microchip database (e.g. Petlog) and any appropriate lost and found pet websites.



7 Create a lost cat flyer

Design a lost cat flyer with a clear photo, description, and your contact information. Distribute it locally.
