DID YOU KNOW?

All horses, ponies and donkeys >18mo (whether competing, companion, retired, broodmare!) require their teeth checked +/- rasped at least once every 12 months. This is due to their anatomy and domesticated diet resulting in the formation of sharp points along the cheek teeth - left untouched, these cause painful ulceration to the inside of the cheeks and tongue. In many cases, 6 monthly checks can also be beneficial - horses are stoic creatures and a lot can change within 12 months of a dental exam, without any outward signs of pain. Frequent checks can therefore pick up on any issues early on, and sharp points prevented from reaching the point of causing ulceration. Our vets are all competent with routine dentistry, and our equine vet, Joanna Sak MRCVS, has a particular interest in this area and spends much of her time treating dental conditions, such as diastemata. We also liaise closely with other dental professionals in the area and visiting specialists.
