

Pet Travel Scheme

How to get your pet ready to travel within Europe

Microchip

- Microchip needs to be implanted before any other part of the process
- Cost £16.20 (if not already done)

Rabies vaccine

- Single injection in back of the neck
- Cost £33.17
- Lasts 3 years

Pet Passport issued

- Pet Passport done at Blue House - cost £54
- **You must wait 21 whole days from the date of the rabies vaccination before travelling.**
- Owner has to sign passport too once issued

Tapeworm treatment

- Must be done 1-5 days (between **24 and 120 hours**) before return to UK
- Given by local vet who then signs passport
- Cost variable!

Preventative health

- Advantix and Milbemax once monthly
- Advantix treats and repels fleas, ticks, mosquitos and sandflies, Milbemax does all worms including lung worm if used monthly.
