Stem Cell therapy is an innovative treatment modality for a range of different conditions. Cedar Grove is among the few centres in the UK providing this treatment.

It is most commonly used in the treatment of osteoarthritis and has also been shown to have great benefits in the treatment of other conditions such as allergic skin disease, degenerate myelopathy, feline gingivitis and auto-immune disease plus a range of other chronic conditions.

CT scanner investment

We have recently installed a SOMATOM go. Now made by Siemens, representing the latest technology in veterinary CT. The software which runs both the image generation and post scan editing is amongst the most advanced and gives a fantastic level of detail while still being a relatively simple and intuitive system to operate.

At Cedar Grove we have always been very proactive in maintaining the highest levels of equipment and diagnostic tools to allow us to give our clients and their pets the best care. We have had an MRI scanner at the clinic since 2014 as well as having advanced x-ray and ultrasonography equipment.

The CT machine provides additional capability to allow us to confidently diagnose the maximum range of conditions across all organ systems, with our comprehensive range of diagnostic tools. We firmly believe that these tools work synergistically to give our clients and their pets the highest levels of care and optimised clinical outcomes.

We can scrutinise many of the more complicated joints of the body and detect a vast range of conditions and problems at an early stage, meaning we can address these conditions and make a greater difference.

When dealing with neurology and spinal cases, the CT is invaluable as a screening tool to locate spinal disease. In many cases, the CT can tell us all we need to know to progress to the next stage of treatment. In cases where additional detail is required to further progress the case, we are privileged to be one of the few practices in Ireland to have on site MRI capability to help unravel the most challenging cases.

The CT machine also adds a huge range of capability in detection and diagnosis of abdominal conditions ranging from portosystemic shunt diagnosis, to ectopic ureter detection and detection and staging of neoplasia cases.

Another great advantage of CT is the vast level of information we can get in a short time frame with little sedation and in a minimally invasive way. We can quickly survey our trauma and acutely ill patients with limited risk allowing us to make life saving decisions for patients within a matter of minutes of them arriving at the clinic.









Advanced facilities and care for your patients

- 24-hour veterinary nursing care supervision.
- Standard anaesthetic monitoring equipment includes ECG, Capnography, Pulse Oximeter, Temperature Monitoring and Blood pressure.
- Intensive care facilities allow us to manage critical medical and surgical cases 24 hours per day.
- Isolation ward is a stand alone unit where we hospitalise patients with infectious disease.
