Senior pets need routine healthcare as much as (if not more than) young pets. We recommend annual blood and urine checks for all senior pets and these are included in the plan.

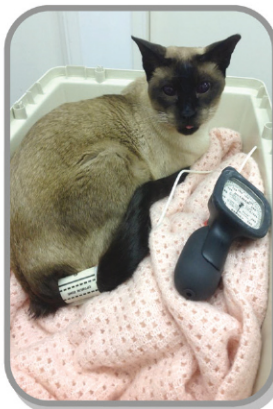
Screening lab work is important for a number of reasons:

- Some pets are very good at hiding their symptoms
- Screening diagnostic tests allow us to examine organ function and unmask illness that may not be detectable by the clinical examination
- The earlier diseases are diagnosed, the earlier they can be treated and the better the long term prognosis
- Waiting until your pet becomes unwell may be too late

Dental disease is very common in some pets so dental care is important. Dental disease can be prevented by stopping the build up of plaque on the teeth which our veterinary team can give you advice on during the regular checks.
