Job Title: Veterinary Nurse (Day/Ward)

General responsibilities	 To nurse patients to a gold standard level in every discipline/ward on a rotation basis. To ensure all questions and potential concerns are raised with the surgeon in charge. To communicate with clients regarding their animals care. To nurse to a high standard following set protocols. To ensure detailed handovers are given between teams. To listen to and support the ward co-ordinator in delivery of patient care. 		
Pricing/ paperwork	Ensuring the patient has been priced correctly, checking grading overnight fees, and ensuring to go home medication sheets have been correctly filled out for the owner		
Recovery	Recovering patients from sedation/anaesthesia.		
Discharges	Discharging patients back to owners, going through medication and discharge instructions.		
Handovers	Attend morning/afternoon and evening rounds with clinicians and give detailed handovers to fellow nurses on the next shift about the patients. Also ensuring all day sheets are signed by the clinician.		
Communication with clients	Discharging patients, giving owners daily phone updates and sending the owners pictures off of the practice phone		
Using Easyvet	Using our in-house computer system to book discharge appointments, visits and clinician phone calls		
Theatre skills	To have an understanding of basic theatre nursing skills to ensure able to deal with emergency patient situations and to be able to help the team as a whole during weekend rotations.
