

## Work Experience Guidelines

- During your time with us we will expect you to arrive at 9.00am and go home at 5.00pm. However, if transport issues make this difficult we can adjust these times.
- You will have one hour for lunch within the working day. Please bring a packed lunch or money to purchase food in town.
- Refreshments in the form of tea/coffee and squash are provided.
- If you are unable to attend due to illness or emergency please contact us as soon as possible.
- You should wear smart/casual clothing, NO jeans, but be aware that you may get dirty and please wear practical footwear. You will be given surgical scrubs to wear if going into the operating theatre.
- Please do not wear heavy makeup or jewelry. If your ears are pierced please only wear studs.
- You should not smoke on or anywhere near the premises
- Please do not use your mobile phone unless you are on your lunch break.
- Please do not sit in the reception/waiting room area.
- Please bring in some reading material in case of very quiet days
- It is recommended that you have a good breakfast before coming in as it can become very warm and this will help to avoid light-headedness in theatre. Fainting is fairly common.
- **If you have any allergies or health complaints please let us know prior to your placement.**
- Please be aware that if we feel you are not benefiting from your placement or act inappropriately at any time, Leonard Brothers Veterinary Centre withholds the right to dismiss you from your work experience placement.
