

Animal Health Certificates

Thank you for choosing McMurtry & Harding to provide you with the travel documents required for your pets. You will need to book an appointment with one of our vets to complete an Animal Health Certificate (AHC) for each pet that will be travelling. We also need some information from you before your appointment to ensure we can complete the AHC correctly, so please complete and submit the form below at least 48 hours before your appointment.

Your appointment will take up to 45 minutes and both the pet and person travelling with the pet **MUST** attend.

On the day of your appointment please bring:

- Proof of identification of your pet
- Proof of your pet's rabies vaccination

If you have a Pet Passport for your pet that was issued before 31st December 2020, we can accept this as proof of identification and vaccination. If you do not have a Pet Passport for your pet, then please bring your vaccination card that shows the last rabies vaccination, and a document confirming your pet has been microchipped. Note: The contact details for the Pet Travel Scheme could change, so if you're unable to get through to them, please contact the practice and we'll do our best to help.

The AHC needs to be completed within 10 days of travel and a Rabies vaccination (if required) needs to be administered at least 21 days before an AHC can be issued. Please also confirm the point of entry into the EU and all countries that you may be travelling through so that we have full information to enable us to complete the form correctly.

If the date of travel changes you must inform the Practice immediately so that we can re-arrange your AHC appointment.

For Dogs, tapeworm treatment is required when travelling from Great Britain to EU listed tapeworm free countries including Northern Ireland, Malta, Ireland, and Finland. These dogs must be treated for tapeworm not more than 120 hours and not less than 24 hours before time of entry into one of these countries.

Before returning to Great Britain, dogs must be treated for tapeworm not less than 24 hours and not more than 120 hours before time of entry, except for return from Northern Ireland, Finland, Ireland, or Malta. You must take your AHC to a vet in the EU country you are in when you have this treatment. If you are leaving Great Britain on a short trip and returning within 120 hours, you need to have this treatment done before leaving.
