We currently have four certificate holders in Internal medicine, Surgery, Ophthalmology and Dermatology; we also have a further two Vets part way through their studies for Surgery Certificates.

Practice facilities are: CT, gastroscopy, bronchoscopy, Ultrasound including cardiac work ups, 24-hour Veterinary lead critical care and orthopaedic facilities. We can also offer onsite hydrotherapy (pool and treadmill) and K Laser.

We are happy to review case notes and give estimates for procedures that we feel we can manage at My Vet and will happily receive referrals from local practices.

Currently our cert holders in dermatology and ophthalmology are on maternity leave so we are hoping to offer these services again in the Spring.
