

COVID -19 UPDATE PLEASE READ

Please note our doors at both surgeries are now open. However please observe the following protocols:

- ONLY ONE client and their pet will be able to enter the practice, please follow our simple rules...
- ONE Client per pet.
- FACE MASKS to be worn by every client
- HAND SANITISER To be used on entry.
- SOCIAL DISTANCING to be observed at all times.
- MAXIMUM of 4 clients waiting for appointments in our waiting rooms at one time.
- Do not come to the practice if you are self-isolating or have any COVID-19 symptoms

We have re designed our waiting areas and consults with floor stickers, tape and one-way systems so you can all social distance correctly. We ask if you can turn up to the practice for your appointment on time and not early. If there are more than four people in the waiting room awaiting their appointment's we will kindly ask you to wait outside until there is available room for you to enter.

If you are shielding or still feel uncomfortable about coming in to the practice please call us when you arrive and we can bring and treat your pet inside whilst you wait in the car.

Park View has missed you all and we can't wait to safely welcome you back in! Please remember that we are still working in two separate teams and on skeleton staff so things may take a little bit longer than usual.
