

→ Additionally, there is no evidence that pets or other domestic animals

→ The new coronavirus (termed 2019-nCoV or COVID-19), canine coronavirus and feline coronavirus all belong to the family Coronaviridae. Viruses from this family can infect both animals and humans. HOWEVER, while the novel coronavirus belongs to the beta-coronaviruses, feline and canine coronaviruses are both alpha-coronaviruses, and there is no current evidence


