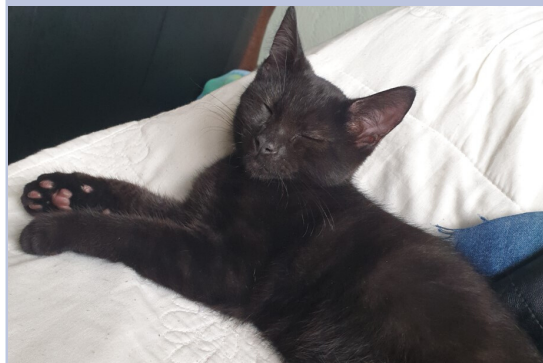

Top Tips for Firework Season

Fireworks are not limited to the 5th November - they are often let off regularly throughout the festive season. They can cause quite a lot of distress to our pets, so here are some handy hints to help you navigate this time of year.

- 1)** Stay home. Firework noises are scary and unfamiliar - don't leave your pet alone with them.
- 2)** Keep your pets indoors where it's safe.
- 3)** Keep your doors, windows and curtains closed to minimise the noise.
- 4)** Provide your pet with somewhere to hide.
- 5)** Walk your dog before it gets dark and the noises start. Always keep them on a lead so they can't run off.
- 6)** Loud TV or music will help distract your pet from what's happening outside.
- 7)** If your pet seems unsettled, use their favourite toy or game to distract them.
- 8)** If your pet seeks attention, give it to them. If they're settled and calm, be sure to praise them.
