Our neuropathic pain clinic is a specialised service designed to provide comprehensive care and support for dogs dealing with ongoing chronic neurological pain through conservative treatment.



About our clinic

During your patients visit a neurologist and a physiotherapist will conduct a thorough assessment including a physical exam and a review of their medical history. They will then discuss treatment options and develop a plan which your client feels comfortable with

Investigations & treatment may include:

- Pain score questionnaire
- Pressure mat
- Activity monitors
- Massage therapy and low impact physiotherapy and exercise
- Acupuncture
- Laser therapy
- First line pain relievers, such as nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drugs
- Neuropathic pain relievers such as gabapentin, pregabalin, amitriptyline, amantadine / memantine
- Epidural or perineural steroids injection

Initial assessment*

Existing cases (internal referral) - £150 New cases - £300

Includes:

- · Evaluation of medical history and investigations performed
- Clinical assessment by a neurologist and physiotherapist
- Gait analysis
- Introduction to activity monitors
- Development of a personalised treatment plan

*Please note, if a patient has been referred but a final diagnoses has not been given we would recommend a neurology consultation (£265) to start and then an internal referral to the clinic (£150) so that we can ensure the best course of treatment.

Recheck

Recheck to discuss case progression - £150 (to be planned after 4, 8 and 12 weeks)

Treatments

- Electroanalgesia (laser therapy) £20 pounds per session
- Hydrotherapy £40
- Physiotherapy £40
- Acupuncture £40
- Activity monitor £40 deposit
- Gait track £20
- Epidural steroid injection under general anaesthetic-£300
- Perineural steroid injection under general anaesthetic £300
