We are happy to assist with trying to clarify if your insurance company will cover your fees.

As skin problems can start with intermittent signs over a long period of time, it is an area where it can be more difficult to be sure that fees will be covered by a specific insurance policy.

Please try and find out BEFORE your appointment if your pet is definitely covered for veterinary costs relating to skin by contacting our Taverham Branch and asking to speak to Rachel, Maria or Joy. Be ready to provide all your insurance details.
