

Paddock Hire

Terms of Use

The Paddock is situated behind the Chalfont St Giles branch of the Wheelhouse Veterinary Centre.

Hire is subject to availability and ground conditions and the following should be noted prior to use:

- The paddock is surrounded by a mixture of fencing, walls, wooden panel and chain link fencing. All fences are approximately 5 feet high except for the gate entrance which is lower.
- The paddock contains a horse chestnut tree; please do not allow your dogs to eat the conkers, when these are present.
- We do not guarantee the paddock to be escape proof, wildlife does dig under the fence sometimes.
- Hire is £9 per hour for one handler and up to three dogs. £17 for multiple handlers and up to six dogs. No more than six dogs in the paddock at any time. However, if you have more dogs you can rotate them round during this time. Dogs may not be left in the paddock unattended at any time.
- Dogs must be currently vaccinated against Parvovirus, Distemper, Hepatitis and Leptospirosis. Proof of this or current immunity from Titre Tests must be shown on first attendance and whenever requested by the practice after this.
- Dogs must also be routinely treated against Lungworm (Angiostrongylus Vasorum), please ask if you need advice on how to treat for this. We do not want the paddock to become a source of infection.
- Dogs <u>may not</u> use the paddock if they have shown any signs of illness (e.g. diarrhoea) in the past 7 days (14 days for signs or exposure to kennel cough).

Before using the paddock please attend reception to pay your fee. You are welcome to bring your dog into the surgery or leave them in the car whilst you do this.

On entering the paddock, the 'Available' sign on the gate must be changed to 'In Use'. There will be a keycode on the gate in order to enter the paddock: reception will provide you with the current code.

All faeces must be picked up and disposed of in the marked bins.

Under no circumstances may any Agility Equipment in the paddock be used or moved.

If you disregard these terms of use you will not be permitted to use the paddock again and will be asked to leave.
